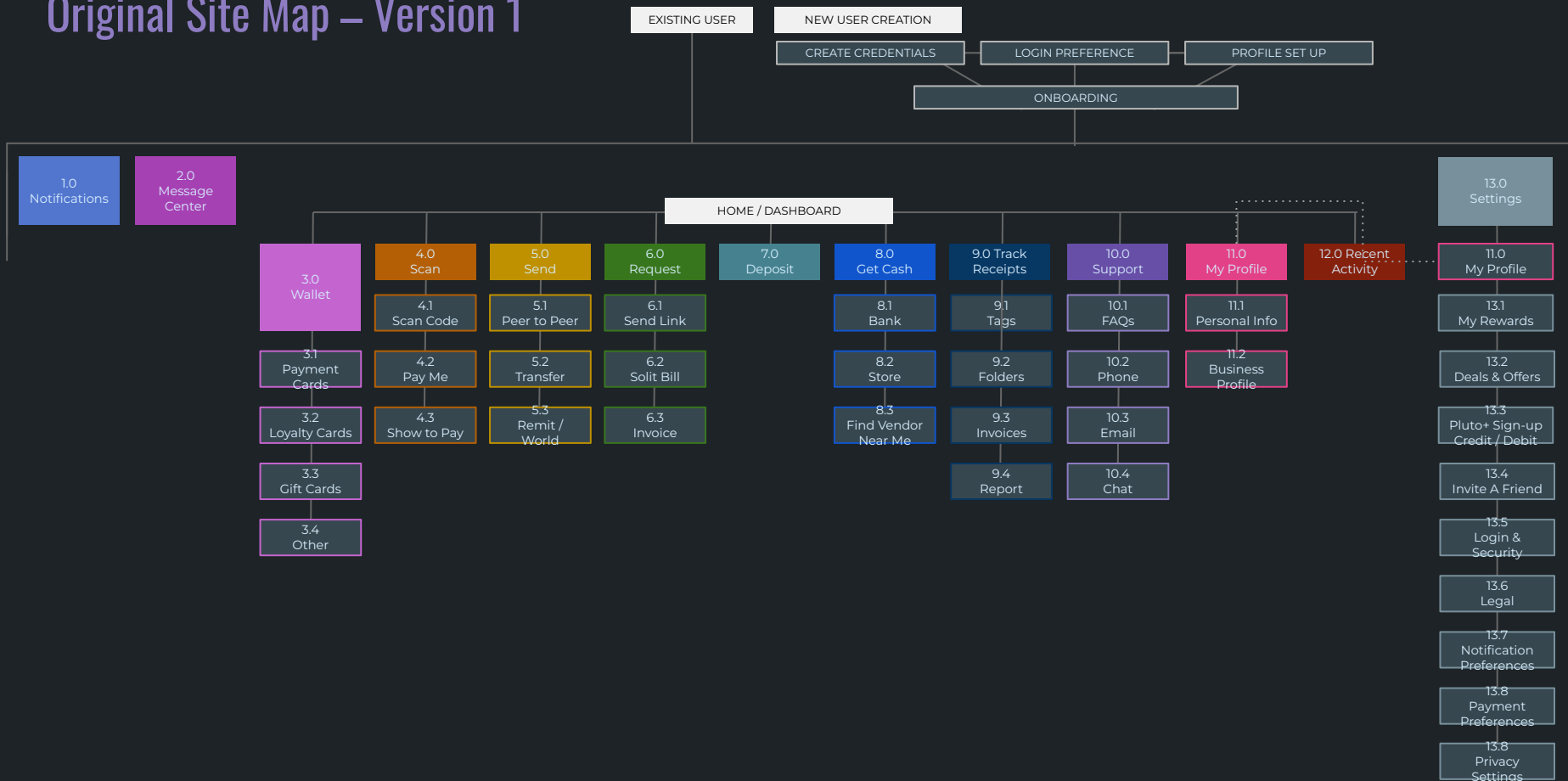

Site Map

Keeping the possible solutions in mind with the user-centric goals, an initial sitemap was created. To test the validity of user associations for an intuitive experience, a card sorting session was conducted.

KEY TAKEAWAYS

After the card sorting session, data showed that I had to re-categorize a few things because they caused confusion.

- Changes:
 - Rethink priority of Walet (*Later on changed to Cards & Accounts*)
 - Consolidated “Recent Activity” and “Track Receipts”
 - Added link to “Personal QR Code” under “My Profile”
 - Added link to “Report/Flag” under “Support”
 - Removed My Rewards, Deals and Offers and Pluto+ Sign Up from Settings to its own category “Rewards, Products and Offers”

Card Sorting

After the card sort, I was able to speak to the participants in general about what they thought of the exercise and some gave rationale to their decisions.

Invite a Friend

7 of the participants thought that this is like a Venmo where a social component is included - all 4 thought that this would be under a notification function, and 3 thought that their profile would show their # of friends.

Invoice a Business

Most people agreed with the proposed location on the sitemap in the context of a payment app would fall under Request Money.

Loyalty Cards

Most people thought it should go in Wallet, but after talking to the participants, more than half of them mentioned that “Wallet” is confusing since they thought the whole app is the “wallet.” This was worth noting and revising.

My Profile

This was self explanatory. The hope is to have this accessible in multiple location since it's a user's identity and one makes it their own.

Notification Preferences

Half of the participants agreed with the proposed location under “Configuration/Settings” After speaking with the other half, two people that said “My Profile” changed their minds as they were talking it through.

Payment Cards

Most people thought it should go in Wallet, but after talking to the participants, more than half of them mentioned that “Wallet” is confusing since they though the whole app is the “wallet.” This was worth noting and revising.

Payment Preferences

6/8 is a pretty good indicator that we’re on the right track.

Peer-to-Peer Payment

5 agreed during card sort. The participant who said “wallet” is one of the people that mentioned that he thought the whole thing was a “wallet” so with that said, he change the answer to “Send Money” as well

Personal QR Code

This seems to be all over the place when it came to the card sort. It maybe something that is kept in mind for next round if there are still any confusion. An option is to create multiple access also for it.

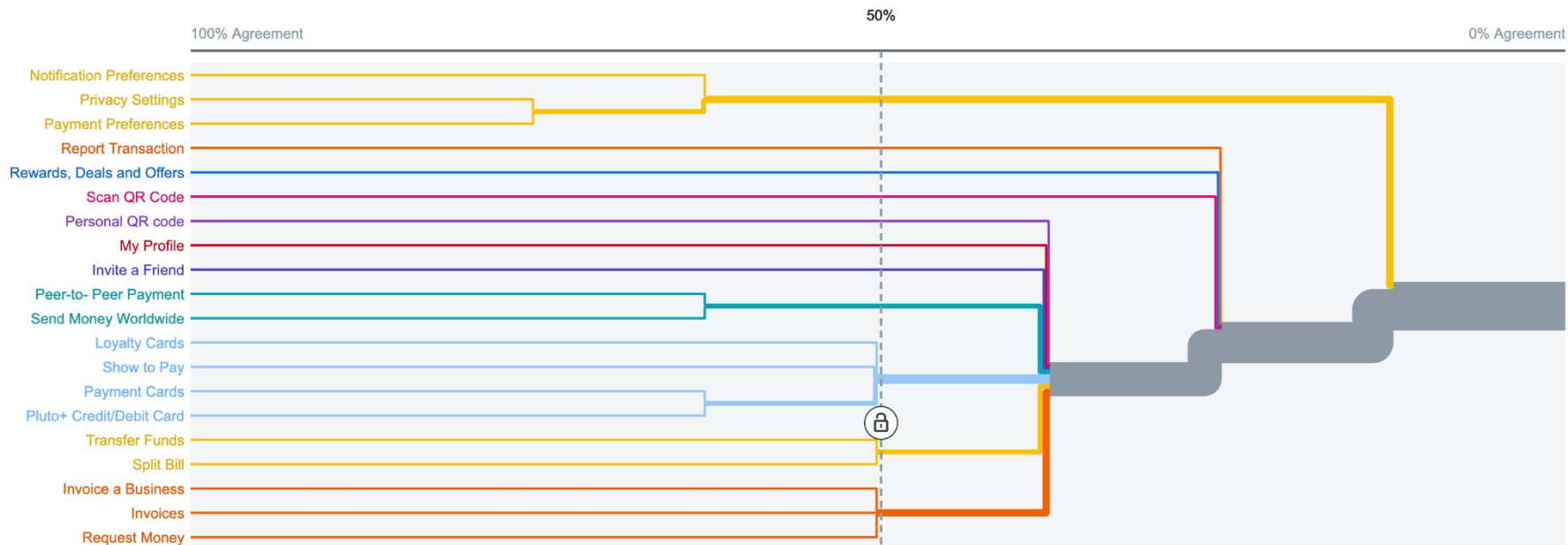

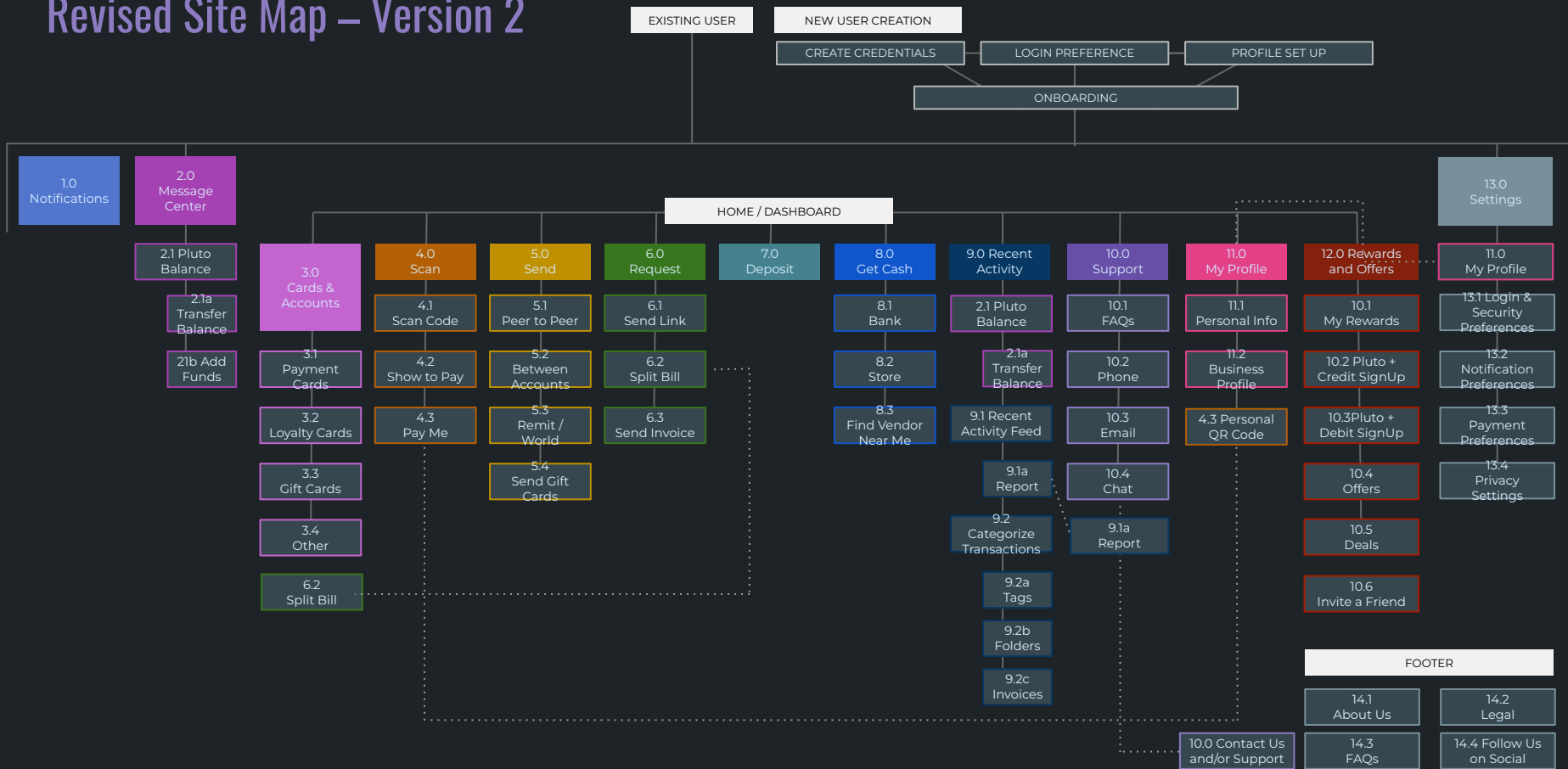
Here's another visual of the grouping from card sorting sessions – the association of similar sets of features

The best merge method often performs better than the actual agreement method when your study has fewer participants. It makes assumptions about larger clusters based on individual pair relationships.

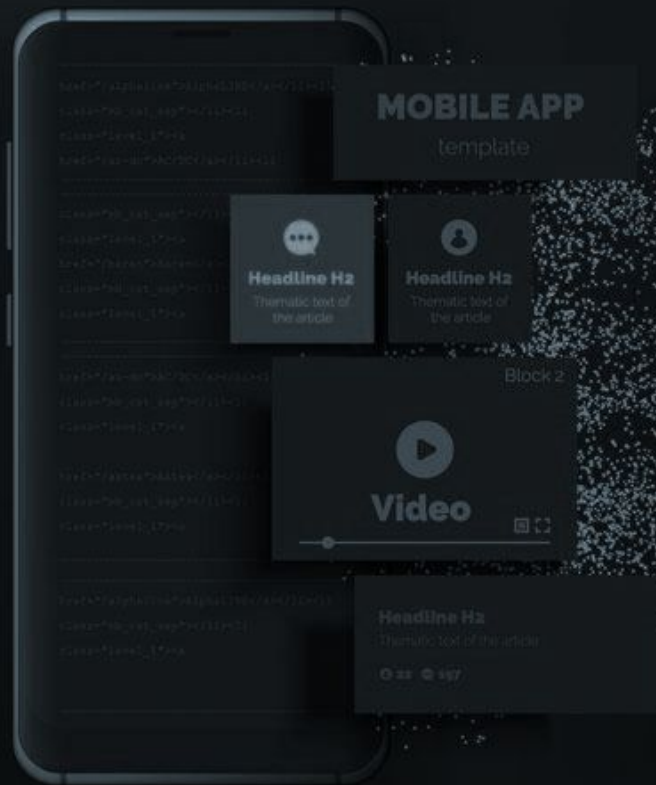


Revised Site Map – Version 2
